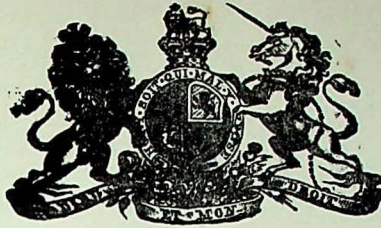

2. The Forest Settlement Officer in Sind is hereby appointed, under clause (c) of the same section, to enquire into and determine the existence, nature and extent of any rights alleged to exist in favour of any person in these lands.

No. 5874.—Whereas it appears to the Governor in Council, on the report of the District Magistrate, Surat, that in the local areas hereinbelow specified subject to the jurisdiction of the said Magistrate cattle are habitually allowed to trespass on land and damage crops or other produce thereon, the Governor in Council is pleased to direct, in exercise of the power conferred upon him by Section 12 of the Cattle Trespass Act, 1871, as amended by Section 5 (1) of Act I of 1891, that on and after the 1st September 1893 for every head of cattle specified in the scale contained in the first-mentioned section which may be seized within any of the said local areas and impounded in accordance with the provisions of the Cattle Trespass Act, 1871, as amended by Act I of 1891, the pound-keeper shall levy a fine equal to double the fine mentioned in the scale aforesaid.

2. No. 5013.—The Governor in Council is pleased to make the following Rule and to direct that it be inserted as No. 48-A in the general body of the Rules regarding the remuneration and duties of the Law Officers of Government for the Presidency proper published at pages 740—746 of the *Bombay Government Gazette* for 1882, Part I (namely) :—

48-A. If in any case coming before the High Court on appeal against a conviction or on

revision under the Code of Criminal Procedure, a question arises as to any proprietary interest asserted on behalf of Government, the Government Pleader in the High Court shall inform the Magistrate of the District in which the case was tried, and also the Remembrancer of Legal Affairs, and shall, when necessary, apply for an adjournment of the case, in order to enable those officers to furnish him with full information on such question before the case is finally heard in the High Court.

No. 1100.—The Governor General in Council is pleased, under Section 17 of the Indian Arms Act (XI of 1878), to make the following addition to Rule 2 of the rules published in the Notification of the Government of India, Home Department, No. 518, dated the 6th March 1879, as added to by Home Department Notification No. 114 dated the 25th January 1883:

Every consignment of arms or ammunition or military stores transported in any part of British India by railway shall be conspicuously marked with the words ‘arms,’ ‘ammunition,’ or ‘military stores,’ as the case may be, in such manner as to be readily recognisable by the Railway authorities. A copy of the license to transport the articles shall be attached to the way-bill when the consignment is booked as a parcel and to the invoice when booked as goods, and no consignment shall leave the railway premises without the contents being verified and compared with the license by the Railway Police at the place of delivery. Telegraphic advice of every such consignment shall be sent to the receiving station by the Railway authorities at the forwarding station.

No. 5144.—The following revised Table of Fares and Subsidiary Rules for public conveyances in the City and Suburban Municipal limits of Poona and the Cantonments of Poona and Kirkee, proposed by the District Magistrate of Poona, in supersession of those published at pages 932 to 934 of the *Bombay Government Gazette* for 1868, Part I, are published for general information, and it is hereby notified that any objections to or suggestions regarding the said revised fares and rules which are delivered in writing at the office of the Secretary to Government in the Judicial Department on or before the 20th September 1893 will be taken by the Governor in Council into his consideration:—

SUBSIDIARY RULES RELATING TO PUBLIC CONVEYANCES.

Under Section 14 of Bombay Act VI of 1863.

1. In every case in which a public conveyance is called from a distance exceeding half a mile to take up a fare, two annas shall be paid in addition to the authorized fare.
2. All return fares shall be one-half of the original fare as herein laid down.
3. The fare for a second class public conveyance for a whole day is Rs. 4 (ten hours to constitute a day). For half a day (five hours) Rs. 2-8-0. For any period less than five hours at 12 annas per hour.
4. As regards Rule No. 3 all persons engaging a public conveyance may, before starting, arrange with the driver thereof as to whether he should be engaged by the day, half day, or by distance. If no such express arrangement is come to between the parties, the driver shall be entitled to his fare according to the Distance Tariffs.
5. No fare for a public conveyance shall be less than 4 annas.
6. The scale of fares supplied to every driver of a public conveyance shall be kept clean and in good order.
7. Any person having cause to complain against the driver of a public conveyance may take such driver to the nearest Police station, where a Police officer will enquire into such complaint, and if possible settle it.
8. Victorias are licensed to carry three, Shigrams four, Buggies and Tongas two passengers.
9. The following to be the scale of detention of conveyances :—
Any period over a quarter and up to half an hour, 2 annas. Every succeeding half hour and fraction of a half hour, an additional 2 annas.

APPENDIX A.

Statement showing particulars pursuant to Rule 5 of the Rules published by the Government of India for the raising of loans by local authorities.

I.—The loan is required for the following work :—

Water works for Sukkur within municipal limits the estimated cost of which is Rs. 2,98,850.

II.—The amount which it is proposed to borrow is Rs. 2,00,000 (two lakhs), the Municipality having already a surplus balance of about Rs. 1,00,000.

III.—It is proposed to borrow the said sum on the security of the general revenues of the Sukkur Municipality aggregating Rs. 97,809-8-7 on the average of three years ending 1892-93, as per Statement B hereto annexed.

IV.—The laws under which fees are levied, received or held are Bombay Acts VI of 1873 and II of 1894.

V.—The loan is required for a period not exceeding 20 years. The money will be received during the official year 1893-94, and in four instalments as under—

- 25 per cent. on application,
- 25 per cent. on allotment,
- 25 per cent. 3 months from date of allotment, and
- 25 per cent. 6 months from date of allotment.

Tenderers paying up in full will receive the interest from date of allotment and will be paid half-yearly at 5 per cent. per annum (5,000+5,000=10,000), and a sum of Rs. 7,000 will be set aside annually as a sinking fund, which with interest accumulating at 4 per cent. will pay off the loan within the period of 20 years.

VI.—The annual receipts and expenditure of the Municipality for the last 3 years are submitted in supplementary Statements B to E (annexed), from which it will appear that the average receipts have been Rs. 97,809-8-7 and the average ordinary expenditure Rs. 81,336-4-2, leaving a balance of Rs. 16,473-4-5.

In addition to this the income expected from private services and water-rate will amount to Rs. 24,768 per annum.

VII.—There are no existing prior charges on the funds of this Municipality.

APPENDIX F.

Explanation of important Variations in Income and Expenditure.

INCOME.

A.—Municipal Taxes.

(1) *Octroi.*—There is a marked variation in the gross and net receipts, due chiefly to the fact that goods are exported from Sukkur very irregularly only when a market for them arises. Sukkur is, if anything, a large dépôt for merchandize brought by river and rail, and warehoused until there is a profitable demand for it. Thus in 1892-93, the decreased produce of ghi in Sind necessitated increased import of this commodity from the Punjab. Then again, owing to the enhanced duty on wood, because of the revision of the schedule of octroi, merchants imported a very large quantity of teak and deodár. The refunds were extremely heavy, and that is attributable to the revision of the rules about collection of octroi and grant of refunds which came into force on the 1st April 1893.

C.—Revenue derived from the Municipal property and powers apart from taxation.

(2) *Sale-proceeds of Land and Produce of Land.*—The increase represents the sale-proceeds of the Bugri Garden to the Taluka Local Board of Rohri. There was also an increase in the number of plots of building land sold during the year.

APPENDIX F—continued.

(8).—Others.

5. *Bandar Fees*.—The decrease under this head is attributed to various causes, viz., failure of rabi crops, high inundation and floods which stopped communication, outbreak of cholera which interfered with business, absence of famine to which the Great Desert and portions of Rájputána were subject last year, less exports to Europe, and to the Forest Department not adjusting the amount of bandar fees due by them, as also to the fact of European firms opening agencies at Ferozpur and exporting direct to Karáchi, and to less exports owing to a prohibitory tax imposed on wheat by the Naváb of Bahawalpur.

E.—Miscellaneous.

2. *Other Items*.—There is a decrease, but in 1891-92 the following unforeseen items were credited :—

- (a) Compensation from Government for building materials on land taken up for Police Lines.
- (b) Share of cost of gymnasium received from Government.
- (c) Grant by His Excellency the Governor of Bombay on his visit to Sukkar.

EXPENDITURE.

A.—General Administration and Collection Charges.

6. The expenditure of Rs. 960 represents the gratuity paid to Mr. Bock, late Sanitary Inspector, against Rs. 1,600 paid in the year previous to Mr. Nash, late Municipal Secretary.

B.—Public Safety.

1. *Fire*.—The increase is due to the purchase of leather and canvas hose and a semaphore during the year 1892-93.

C.—Public Health.

1. *Water-supply*.—This expenditure is classed as extraordinary, and is due to the employment of a qualified Engineer officer and a staff of surveyors to prepare the water-works scheme. The necessary plans and estimates have been framed, and will be submitted to the Sanitary Board for opinion.

2. *Drainage Works*.—Under capital is included an extraordinary charge on account of compensation awarded by the Civil Court for damage done to a private building from the bursting of a water pipe.

Under Establishment the increase is partly due to the increased consumption of fuel owing to an inferior kind having been supplied by the Forest Department, and partly to adjustment of bills for the cost of fuel supplied by the Forest Department in the previous year.

3. *Conservancy*.—Increase chiefly due to the purchase of iron dust bins, and has been shown as an extraordinary charge.

4. *Hospitals and Dispensaries*.—This includes a contribution of Rs. 5,000 towards the Lady Dufferin Female Hospital Shikárpur Fund, which is an extraordinary charge.

II.—Public Works.

(ii) *Buildings*.—Increase caused through the adjustment of previous year's bills on account of repairs to buildings.

(iii) *Roads*.—There is a decrease under this head. No new roads were constructed during the year, only portions of three important ones were remodelled. In 1891-92 extensive repairs had been made to roads, and therefore it was not necessary to spend large sums on this account in 1892-93.

D.—Public Instruction.

2. *Contribution*.—Decrease due to the third instalment towards the Mahomedan Madressah Building Fund not having been paid during 1892-93. In 1891-92 Rs. 2,000 were contributed on this account.

E.—Miscellaneous.

4.—*Other Items*.—The increase is due to the purchase of machinery, tools and plant.
