PART IV.

ACTS PASSED BY THE COVERNMENT OF BOMBAY.

The following Act of the Governor of Bombay in Council received the assent of His Excellency the Governor on the 3rd April 1895, and the assent of His Excellency the Viceroy and Governor General on the 30th July 1895, and is published for general information:—

Bombay Act No. II of 1895.

An Act to amend " The Bombay Tramways Act, 1874."

(The assent of the Governor General of India to this Act was published by the Governor of Bombay on the 28th August 1895.)

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Bombay Tramways Act, 1874, in manner hereinafter appearing; it is enacted as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Bombay
 Tramways Act Amendment Act of 1895.
- Amendment section 3 of the Bombay Tramways Act, 1874, after the words "a single track" wherever they occur—

- (a) in the fourth, and
- (b) in the fifth

paragraphs thereof, there shall be added the following, viz.:—

"or such double track as may, at any time with the previous consent of the said Corporation, be approved by the Municipal Commissioner and be sanctioned by Government."

(2) The proviso in the fifth paragraph of the said section is repealed.
