PART IV.

ACTS PASSED BY THE COVERNMENT OF INDIA.

LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.

The following Act of the Governor General of India in Council received the assent of His Excellency the Governor General on the 10th October, 1895, and is hereby promulgated for general information:—

Act No. XV of 1895.

An Act to explain the Transfer of Property Act, 1882, so far as relates to grants from the Grown and to remove certain doubts as to the powers of the Grown in relation to such grants.

IV of 1882.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the extent and operation of the Transfer of Property Act, 1882, and as to the power of the Crown to impose limitations and restrictions upon grants and other transfers of land made by it or under its authority, and it is expedient to remove such doubts; It is hereby enacted as follows:

Title, extent and commencement. 1. (1) This Act may be called the Crown Grants Act. 1895.

- (2) It extends to the whole of British India;
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
 - 2. Nothing in the Transfer of Property Act, IV of 1832

Transfer of Property
Act, 1882, not to apply to
Crown grants.

1882, contained shall apply or be deemed ever to
have applied to any grant
or other transfer of land

or of any interest therein heretofore made or hereafter to be made by or on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen-Empress, her heirs or successors, or by or on behalf of the Secretary of State for India in Council to, or in favour of, any person whomsover; but every such grant and transfer shall be construed and take effect as if the said Act had not been passed.

3. All provisions, restrictions, conditions and

Crown grants to take effect according to their tenor.

limitations over contained in any such grant or transfer as aforesaid shall be valid and take effect accord-

ing to their tenor, any rule of law, statute or enactment of the Legislature to the contrary not-withstanding.

LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.

The following Act of the Governor General of India in Council received the assent of His Excellency the Governor General on the 10th October 1895, and is hereby promulgated for general information :-

Act No. XVI of 1895.

- An Act to repeal certain obsolete Enactments and to amend certain other Enactments.

WHEREAS it is expedient that certain enactments specified in the first schedule to this Act, which are spent, or have ceased to be in force otherwise than by express, specific repeal, or have by lapse of time or otherwise become unnecessary, should be expressly and specifically repealed;

And whereas it is also expedient that certain formal amendments should be made in the enactments specified in the second schedule to this Act:

It is hereby enacted as follows:

Title, extent and com-

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Repealing and Amending Act, 1895.
- (2) It extends to the whole of the territories administered by the Governor of Bombay in Council; and
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. (1) The enactments specified in the first Enactments in first and second schedules repealed

and amended respectively.

schedule are hereby repealed to the extent men--tioned in the fourth column thereof.

- (3) The enactments specified in the second schedule shall be modified to the extent and in the manner mentioned in the fourth column thereof.
- 3. The repeal by this Act of any enactment shall not affect any Statute, Act or Regulation in which such enactment has been applied, incorporated or referred to;

and this Act shall not affect the validity, invalidity, effect or consequences of anything already done or suffered, or any right, title, obligation or liability already acquired, accrued or incurred, or any remedy or proceeding in respect thereof, or any release or discharge of or from any debt, penalty, obligation, liability, claim or demand, or any indemnity already granted, or the proof of any past act or thing;

nor shall this Act affect any principle or rule of law, or established jurisdiction, form or course of pleading, practice or procedure, or existing usage, custom, privilege, restriction, exemption, office or appointment, notwithstanding that the same respectively may have been in any manner affirmed by, recognized in or derived from any enactment hereby repealed;

nor shall the repeal by this Act of any enactment provide or restore any jurisdiction, office. custom, liability, right, title, privilege, restriction, exemption, usage, practice, procedure or other matter or thing not now existing or in
