## ACTS PASSED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA.

#### LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.

The following Act of the Governor General of India in Council received the assent of His Excellency the Governor General on the 22nd July 1897, and is hereby promulgated for general information : -

#### Act No. XIV of 1897.

An Act to facilitate the citation of certain Acts.

WHEREAS it is expedient to facilitate the citation of certain Acts; it is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Short Title and commencement. Short Titles Act, 1897; Title and commencement, and
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Each of the Acts described in the first three columns of the Citation of Acts described schedule may, without in schedule. prejudice to any other

mode of citation, be cited for all purposes by the short title mentioned in that behalf in the fourth column thereof.
