FORT WILLIAM,

the 30th April 1852.

The following Act, passed by the Governor General of India in Council on the 30th April 1852, is hereby promulgated for general information:—

Act No XXII. of 1852.

To avoid doubts as to the Validity of certain Decisions in Summary Suits for Arrears of Rent, and of certain Sales of Putnee Talooks and other Saleable Tenures.

Whereas by Regulation VIII. of 1831 of the Bengal Code the hearing and decision of summary suits, or claims relating to arrears or exactions of rents, were transferred from the Judges of the Zillah or City Courts to the Collectors of the several Districts; and whereas by Regulation VII. of 1832 of the Bengal Code, the superintendence of the sales of Putnee Talooks and other saleable tenures of the class specified in Clause 1, Section VIII. Regulation VIII. of 1819 of the same Code, was transferred to the Collector or Deputy Collector of Land Revenue, or Head Assistant to the Collector or Deputy Collector, subject to an appeal, as therein provided; and whereas by Act VIII. of 1835 the conduct of sales of Talooks or other saleable tenures in execution of summary decrees for rent, in conformity with Regulation VII. of 1799 of the same Code, was transferred to the Collectors of Land Revenue; and whereas doubts have been entertained in some instances as to the District within which such summary suits or claims should have been decided, and such sales made, by reason that the jurisdiction of the several Zillah and City Courts is not continuous with the jurisdiction of the several Collectors of Land Revenue, It is enacted as follows:—

I. No order or decision already made in any such summary suit, and no such sale as aforesaid, already made, which has not been questioned before a Court of competent jurisdiction before the passing of this Act, on the ground of having been decided or made by a Collector of Land Revenue, his Deputy, or duly authorized assistant, having no jurisdiction therein, shall be liable to be annulled or disputed on that ground.

FORT WILLIAM,

The following Act, passed by the Governor General of India in Council on the 7th May 1852, is hereby promulgated for general information:—

Act No. XXIII. of 1852.

To authorize and empower the Governors in Council of the respective Presidencies of Madras and Bombay to mitigate or discharge fines, amerciaments, &c. imposed by the Supreme Courts, or any other Courts of Justice, at Madras and Bombay respectively.

Whereas the Supreme Court of Judicature at Madras now hath certain power and authority to mitigate and discharge fines, amerciaments, forfeitures, and sums of money ordered, adjudged, set, imposed, or awarded by the said Supreme Court of Judicature at Madras, upon or against any person or persons whomsoever for or by reason of any offences, misdemeanors, defaults, contempts, neglects, or forfeitures whatsoever. And whereas the Supreme Court of Judicature at Bombay hath certain power and authority to mitigate and discharge fines, amerciaments, forfeitures, and sums of money ordered, charged, adjudged, set, imposed, or awarded by the said Supreme Court of Judicature at Bombay, upon or against any person

or persons whomsoever, for or by reason of any offences, misdemeanors, defaults, contempts, neglects, or forfeitures whatsoever: And whereas it is expedient that such respective powers and authorities should be exercised by the respective Governors in Council of the Presidencies of Madras and Bombay respectively, It is hereby enacted as follows:—

I. The powers and authorities respectively exercised by the said Supreme Courts at Madras and Bombay, or by any other Courts of Justice at Madras and Bombay respectively, to mitigate and discharge fines, amerciaments, forfeitures, and sums of money ordered, charged, adjudged, set, imposed, or awarded by such Supreme Courts, or by any other Court of Justice at Madras and Bombay aforesaid, upon or against any person or persons whomsoever, for or by reason of any offences, misdemeanors, defaults, contempts, neglects, or forfeitures whatsoever, shall henceforth respectively cease and determine.

II. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council of the Presidency of Fort St. George at Madras to mitigate or discharge all fines, amerciaments, forfeitures, and sums of money which may have been, or may hereafter be, ordered, adjudged, set, imposed, or awarded by the said Supreme Court of Judicature at Fort St. George at Madras aforesaid, or by any other Court of Justice, or other person or persons there having lawful authority to order, charge, adjudge, set, impose, or award fines, amerciaments, ransoms, forfeitures, penalties, or sums of money for, or by reason of, any offences, misdemeanors, defaults, contempts, neglects, or forfeitures whatsoever, as the Court of Exchequer in England, or the Chancellor or Barons thereof, may or can lawfully do in England. And the said Governor in Council may, by any order, cause a share or proportion of any fine imposed on any person or persons for any delinquency or misdemeanor prosecuted to judgment, to be paid over to the prosecutor towards defraying his expenses occasioned thereby, as such Governor in Council shall think fit and expedient.

III. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council of the Presidency of Bombay to mitigate or discharge all fines, amerciaments, forfeitures, and sums of money, which may have been, or may hereafter be, ordered, adjudged, set, imposed, or awarded by the said Supreme Court of Judicature at Bombay, or by any other Court of Justice, or other person or persons there, having lawful authority to order, charge, adjudge, set, impose, or award fines, amerciaments, ransoms, forfeitures, penalties, or sums of money, for or by reason of any offences, misdemeanors, defaults, contempts, neglects, or forfeitures whatsoever, as the Court of Exchequer in England or the Chancellor or Barons thereof, may or can lawfully do in England: And the said last mentioned Governor in Council may, by any order, cause a share or proportion of any fine imposed on any person or persons for any delinquency, or misdemeanor prosecuted to judgment, to be paid over to the prosecutor, towards defraying his expenses occasioned thereby, as such Governor in Council shall think fit and expedient.

1. All Officers in Command of the Honorable Company's Ships and Vessels of the Indian Navy are, as heretofore, to afford every possible aid to Vessels in distress or danger, or in want of casual assistance, and no claims for Salvage are to be raised for such assistance unless really important services, or services accompanied with hazard, have been rendered to such Vessels.

2. When such services have been rendered, the Commanding Officer of the Ship is to transmit a full report of the whole circumstances of the case, with a copy of the Ship's Log, to the Commander in Chief, (through the Senior Naval Officer of the Station,) whose written approval shall be requisite before any Officer under his Command can raise a claim for Salvage, and such approval is not to be given unless really important service, or service accompanied with hazard, has been rendered.

3. In cases where relays of men are sent for the purpose of affording assistance, and where a large portion of the Crew have been employed, the Salvage which may be awarded is to be distributed according to the provisions of the Prize Proclamation in force at the time, unless specially apportioned by the terms of any decree or award, or otherwise to be divided among the parties actually employed, as may be directed.

4. All Officers are to use their best efforts to save and protect property and Stores, especially those belonging to the Crown or the Government, which may be on board any Vessel placed in circumstances of danger or distress; and, if necessary, to remove such Stores to a place of safety. The Commander in Chief of the Indian Navy is requested to transmit these instructions to Officers employed at distant Stations by the earliest opportunities.

GENERAL DEPARTMENT.

The following Rules, which will in future be binding on Candidates for admission into the lower grades of the Public Service, are published for general information :—

1. The usual Members of the Judge's and Collector's Establishment, who form at present the District Examination Committees annually assembled for the purpose in each Collectorate, associated with the Superintendents of the Schools in each Division under the Board of Education, will, for the future, meet *biennially* at the several Sudder Stations, for the Examination of Candidates for public employ.
2. The time of assembling the Committee will be the month of July; the Collector and Magistrate is the Officer appointed to convene the Committee. Before one or other of these Committees Candidates will present themselves for examination, and they will only be eligible for the public service on receiving a Certificate of qualification from the Committee.
3. The period during which these Examinations will continue is limited to 10 days.
4. No Candidate will be examined under the age of 16 years, or past the age of 25.
5. To entitle him to be examined, the Candidate must produce before the Committee a Certificate from a Schoolmaster, either Government or private, that he has a good knowledge of reading, writing, and arithmetic; and this Certificate must be countersigned by a Moonsiff or Mamlutdar, who is further to certify that the Candidate bears a respectable character.
6. Before the Committee the Candidate will be required to read and write well the language of the country; to understand Accounts, and have some knowledge of the forms in which Native Bankers keep their books; and, if a Candidate for Revenue employ, of the Lithographed (Blane's) Form of Accounts. He should also exhibit some acquaintance with the History and Geography of India, and have a fair knowledge of the principal Civil or Criminal Regulations, if for Judicial or Police employ; and of the Joint Report Rules if for Revenue employ in Districts in which Revenue Surveys are being administered.
7. The Committee will be directed to assign, according to the present system of classification by annas, a certain number of annas of classification to a knowledge of the History and Geography of India, but they will not be allowed to assign so many annas as would give proficients in those branches, who know nothing of Accounts, Regulations, or Field-work, a preference over other Candidates well versed in such matters.
8. The Board of Education are authorized, in communication with such Collector and Judge, to appoint annually to the first situation of 10 rupees salary which may become vacant in the principal Cutcherry or Adawlut of each Collectorate or Zilla throughout the country, a Pupil who shall have attained a standard of qualification which the Board, with the sanction of Government, may hereafter fix. Government are to be informed by the Board, at the close of each year, of the appointments so made, and also to be furnished with copy of a Report, which is to be furnished to the Board by the several Heads of the Departments, descriptive of the conduct and advancement in the Service of the person so appointed.
9. The above Rule is subject to this proviso, that the Nominee, if educated in an English School, possesses a knowledge of the Vernacular of the District in which he is to be employed.
10. After the ~~last~~ Committee has assembled, no Candidate for employment under Government shall be received into the public service, nor shall his services be accepted in any Civil public Office even as an Omedwar, unless he has submitted to the preliminary tests prescribed by these Rules.
11. The first meeting of the several Committees is to take place in July 1853.
12. As regards Peons, His Lordship in Council has been pleased to lay down as a rule for future observance, that when two persons equally qualified in other respects for Peon work are desirous of obtaining service under the Government, the preference is to be given to the applicant who can read and write. Persons borne, however, on the Peon Establishment, are not to perform other duties. No persons but those of the Castes and class usually serving as Peons are to receive employment as Peons; young, hale, and active men are to be preferred to others who are more infirm; and as persons of this class are not entitled to Pension, the claims of Peons who have long served the Government, to have their sons or near relations provided with places, are to be duly attended to.
