No. 3886. — *Corrigendum.*—In Government Notification No. 2338G, dated 23rd June 1885, published at page 797 of Part I. of the *Bombay Government Gazette* dated 25th idem, for "the 1st October 1885," fixed as the date on which the newly constituted bodies of municipal commissioners in Belgaum, Nipáni, Gokák, Saundatti, Yamkanmardi and Athni in the Belgaum Collectorate shall commence their terms of office, read "the 15th October 1885."

No. 3894.—With reference to Government Notification No. 2054, dated 3rd June 1885, the following rules under Section 12 of the Bombay District Municipal Act Amendment Act, 1884, for the Municipal District of Chiplún in the Ratnágiri Collectorate are published for general information:—

Under the provisions of Sections 11 and 12 (a) and (b) of the Bombay District Municipal Act Amendment Act, 1884, the Governor in Council is pleased to direct that the Municipal Commission of Chiplún in the district of Ratnágiri shall consist of sixteen members, and shall be constituted partly by election and partly by nomination by the Commissioner, Southern Division.

The number of elected members of the commission shall be eight and of those nominated by the Commissioner, Southern Division, shall be eight, out of whom four may be salaried servants of Government and four shall be non-official private gentlemen.

The Governor in Council is also pleased to direct that "the District Municipal Election Rules" published under Section 12 (c) of Bombay Act II. of 1884, under Government Notification No. 115, dated 14th January 1885, with the addition made to them by Government Notification No. 561, dated 17th February 1885, shall apply to the said Municipal District of Chiplún, and in addition thereto to issue the following order under Rules 2 and 5 (h):—

For electoral purposes the said Municipality of Chiplún shall divide the municipal district subject to its authority into eight wards and determine that one of the elective commissioners shall be elected in each ward. The boundaries of the several wards shall be as specified in Appendix A.

The minimum amount of direct municipal taxes the payment of which shall entitle a person to have his name entered in the list of voters of the Municipal District of Chiplún shall be Re. 1 per annum.

The elections of the municipal commissioners for the said Municipal District of Chiplún shall take place on the 3rd December 1885.

APPENDIX A.

Statement showing the boundaries of each of the eight Wards of the Municipal District of Chiplún formed for the purpose of Municipal elections.

I.—Ward “Muradpur and North Kasba Chiplún” shall comprise the space bounded on—

The North—by the Washisthi river.

The East—by a line drawn straight from the north-east corner of the temple of Gandhareshwar to the south-east corner of Ramtirth tank.

The South—by the road which passes by the southern side of Ramtirtha and going by the old temple of Bahiri joins the Chiplún town road.

The West—by the road which, going by the temple of Bahiri, passes through Wáni-wathar (quarter) and Musalmán-wathar to the bridge over the Lendi brook and thence, passing by the east of the houses of Mithagaris situated on the slope called Pawasali Jambli, joins the Washisthi river.

II.—Ward “Kasba Chiplún” shall comprise the space bounded on—

The North—by the southern boundary of Ward No. I.

The East—by the road which, passing from the south-east corner of the Ramtirtha tank and going from above the northern margin of the Pawan tank and passing behind the temple of Maruti, joins the road leading into the town at the pimpal tree.

The South—by the road which, going by the temple of Maruti, passes on to the northern bank of the Shiwa river by the southern side of the Mámlatdár's kacheri.

The West—by the road which, beginning from the northern bank of the Shiwa river and going by the house of Shabudin Desai, passes through the Musalmán quarter and joins the road leading to Parashram at the point where the house of Shaikh Mahamad valad Gulam Mahamad Palnak stands.

III.—Ward “South Kasba Chiplún” shall comprise the space bounded on—

The North—by the southern boundary of Ward No. II and by the western side of the road which, going towards Parashram by the house of Shaikh Mohidin valad Gulam Mohidin Palnak, joins the Washisthi river at the slope called Jambli.

The East—by a line drawn straight from the south-east corner of Ramtirtha tank to the north-west corner of the house of Ramnak Parasnak Mhar Gosavi in Survey No. 165 of Kasba Chiplún.

The South—by a line drawn straight from the north-west corner of the house of Ramnak Parasnak Mhar Gosavi in Survey No. 165 of Kasba Chiplún to the pimpal tree on the bank of the Shiwa river in Survey No. 185 of Kasba Chiplún.

The West—by the Shiwa river.

IV.—Ward “Pag” shall comprise the space bounded on—

The North—by the southern boundary of Ward No. III.

The East—by the hill between the villages of Kasba Chiplún and Dhamnavne.

The South—by the northern boundary of the village of Kapsal.

The West—by the Shiwa river.

V.—Ward “Bázár” shall comprise the space bounded on—

The North—by the Washisthi river.

The East—by the Shiwa river from its junction with the Washisthi river to the bridge over it.

The South—by the Kumbharli road from the bridge over the Shiwa river to the point where the Durgwadi road joins it, thence by the Durgwadi road to its junction with the Bhatwadi road, and thence by the Bhatwadi road to its junction with the eastern boundary of the village of Uktad.

The West—by the eastern boundary of the village of Uktad.

VI.—Ward “Khend Mirjoli” shall comprise the space bounded on—

The North—by that portion of the Bhatwadi road which forms part of the southern boundary of Ward No. V.

The East—by the Bhatwadi road from its junction with the Durgwadi road to the temple of Jakhmata.

The South—by the Survey Nos. 50, 54, 55, and 189 of the village of Mirjoli.

The West—by the hill to the west of the Wáni-wathar of Mirjoli.

VII.—Ward “Khend Chiplún” shall comprise the space bounded on—

The North—by the Durgwadi road from the Durgwadi hill to its junction with the Kumbharli road, and thence by the Kumbharli road to the bridge over Shiwa river.

The East—by the Shiwa river.

The South—by the northern boundary of the village of Kapsal.

The West—by the eastern boundary of the village of Mirjoli.

VIII.—Ward “Peth Map and Gawal” shall comprise the space bounded on all the four sides by the Washisthi river.
