MY LORD MARQUIS,

I have considered in Council your letter No. 52, dated the 28th of October, transmitting with your Resolution thereon the reports received from Local Governments and Administrations showing the action taken for the destruction of wild animals and venomous snakes during the year 1890.

2. It is satisfactory to observe that the exertions of the Local Governments and Administrations have been attended with some measure of success, and I trust that the serious consideration which has been given to this matter by Your Excellency in Council may secure even better results in future.

"Note by Sir Joseph Fayer, dated the 24th November 1891.

It is satisfactory in reading this report [No. 52 of 1891, Government of India, Home Department] to find that the subject of the destruction of life by wild animals and snakes continues to receive the serious consideration of the Government of India.

The returns show that 23,872 human beings and 68,480 cattle were destroyed during the year under report [1890], and that on the other hand 14,604 wild animals and 510,659 snakes were destroyed. If this be compared with the returns of the preceding year, i.e.,—

Human beings destroyed	25,204	} 1889,
Cattle ditto	69,550	
Wild animals ditto	17,638	
Snakes ditto	578,415	

it will be seen that some progress has been made towards the mitigation of this evil, although if we revert to ten years ago [1880]—

Human beings destroyed	21,990	} 1880,
Cattle ditto	58,386	
Wild animals ditto	14,890	
Snakes ditto	212,776	

we find that but little or no progress has been made during those years.

It is also satisfactory to find that the Supreme Government of India does not take the same desponding view as some of its subordinate authorities noticed in my last memorandum, and I venture to think that there can be little doubt that if sustained and well-organised measures continue to be enforced, a much greater mitigation—though perhaps never extinction—of the evil will take place.

I am glad to find that the pictures illustrating poisonous snakes are in some districts being circulated; with them there can be no difficulty in identifying a poisonous snake, and I therefore hope they will be more widely diffused throughout India. It is obviously quite useless to give rewards for innocent snakes; there can be no difficulty in distinguishing them, and for the destruction of venomous snakes, I strongly recommend that there should be an organised system of rewards everywhere. I would again urge the improbability that snakes would be bred as a matter of profit. This has been made an objection to the giving of rewards, but it is obviously a futile one, for it would never pay to breed poisonous snakes seeing the time they take to reach their full development, and no rewards should be given for any but poisonous snakes.

It is also satisfactory to see that higher rewards are being given for some of the larger destructive animals, such as rogue elephants, leopards, bears, and wolves. This action on the part of Government is most encouraging.

The probable relaxation of forest laws and the facilitating of shooting parties by officers and others—by such means as the loan of Government elephants—would all tend to diminish a death-cause, which is out of proportion even to the great population of the Indian Empire."
