## JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT.

*Bombay Castle, 26th June 1888.*

No. 3287.—The following rules framed by the Honourable the Chief Justice and Judges of the High Court under Sections 20 and 22 of the Court Fees Act, VII of 1870, confirmed by the Government of Bombay and sanctioned by the Governor General of India in Council, are published for general information :—

## RULES UNDER THE COURT FEES ACT.

I.—The fees at present levied for serving and executing processes issued by the High Court in its Appellate Jurisdiction shall continue to be levied.

II.—The fees chargeable by all other Civil Courts shall be those shown in the appended table.

III.—The remuneration of bailiffs, peons and other persons employed by any Civil Court, other than the High Court, in the service and execution of processes, shall be as follows :—

Remuneration to European bailiffs.

When it is necessary to entertain a European bailiff, the pay of such bailiff shall be Rs. 50.

IV.—The whole number of the process-serving establishment employed by the Civil Courts in each district shall be divided into five classes receiving the respective remuneration shown in the last rule.

V.—Provided that no bailiff or peon shall be placed in the Third Class unless he is able to read and write well, nor in the Fourth Class unless he is able to read and write fairly.

VI.—In fixing the number of bailiffs and peons required to serve processes, District Judges shall consider that the average number of processes, which can be served during the year by each bailiff or peon, is as follows :—

VII.—In fixing the number of subordinates required to serve processes in any Court of Small Causes, District Judges shall consider that the average number of processes, which can be served by each bailiff or peon, is as follows :—

VIII.—When the salary of any bailiffs or peons is paid by the party requiring their services (see the 5th exception below), additional temporary bailiffs or peons may be employed to a number not exceeding that of the men whose salary is thus paid. If no additional men are employed, the amount should be credited to Government.

IX.—The following table contains the prescribed fees chargeable in Civil Courts in respect of Processes and Proclamations :—

\* In suits in which the plaint is stamped with a stamp of Rs. 10 under Article 17 or of Rs. 5 under Article 15 of Schedule II of the Court Fees Act, the process fees leviable will be eight and four annas respectively.

The fees above prescribed are to be charged for every proclamation made, and in the case of other processes for each individual ordered to be served with a process. Where one individual is to be served in more than one capacity, e.g. personally and also as guardian of a minor or minors, only one fee is to be levied.

*Exceptions.*

1st.—When a process issued by a Civil Court other than a Mámlatdárs' Court is returned unserved, and has to be re-issued for service, a half fee only shall be charged on the occasion of each re-issue. When a notice or summons issued by a Mámlatdárs' Court is

returned unserved, and has to be re-issued for service, a fee of two annas only shall be charged on the occasion of each re-issue.

This rule applies whatever may be the reason which prevented service (e.g. whether the failure to serve was due to the fault of the party on whose behalf it was issued or not), and whether the identical paper is re-issued or a fresh paper.

2nd.—When the service is set aside in an inquiry under Section 82, Civil Procedure Code, or when witnesses, &c., have to be summoned a second time in consequence of the Court not sitting on the day for which they were first summoned, no further fee is to be levied upon re-issue.

3rd.—The following processes shall be charged for at double the above rates:—

- (1) Warrant for the arrest of a defendant or a witness.
- (2) Injunction against waste, &c.
- (3) Injunction to restrain from repetition or continuance of breach of contract or wrongful act.
- (4) Order of attachment before judgment of the property of a defendant, or of an absconding witness.

4th.—No fee shall be charged for any process issued by a Court of its own motion for the purpose of taking cognizance of any contempt of its authority.

5th.—(a) When the services of one or more bailiffs or peons are required for a longer period than three days, the party on whose application the process was issued shall, in addition to the fee leviable under the above rules, be required to pay the whole salary of such bailiffs or peons for the whole period in excess of three days.

(b) The time occupied in going to and returning from the place at which service of process is to be made shall not be reckoned as a portion of the above period.

(c) If the amount payable on account of salary under the above rule shall involve a fractional part of an anna, such part shall be remitted.

6th.—No process fee shall be charged on proclamations under Section 10 of Regulation VIII of 1827.

X.—(a) The fees levied for all processes in suits to which Chapter II of the Dekkhan Agriculturists' Relief Act (XVII of 1879) applies, except suits of the description mentioned in Section 3, Clauses (w) and (z), to which an agriculturist

is not a party, shall be one-half the fees which would be leviable in similar suits, to which the said Act does not apply.

(b) No fee shall be levied for the service of any notice or other process issued in proceedings taken under Chapter IV of the Dekkhan Agriculturists' Relief Act, XVII of 1879.

(c) Nothing contained in these rules, nor in any rules heretofore made by the High Court under Section 20 of the Court Fees Act (VII of 1870), shall apply to process issued by a Village Munsif under Chapter V of the said Act (XVII of 1879).

XI.—No Court-fee is leviable upon a certificate of a decree-holder under Section 258 of the Civil Procedure Code, although such certificate declares that the judgment-creditor has received a smaller sum or a thing of less value in discharge of a larger sum due under the decree, or in complete discharge of the decree.

XII.—Before any process is issued in any Court, the proper officer of the Court should calculate the amount to be paid as Court-fees, and should give information of such amount to the person by whom the fees are payable. Such fees should be paid before the end of the fourth day after the day on which such information is given. The Court may, for sufficient reason, extend the time for payment.

The stamps received for Court-fees should be affixed to the application upon which the process is to be issued.

After the fees have been received but not before, the necessary summons, notice, warrant, or other process should be prepared.

When the process is to be issued beyond the jurisdiction of the Court, a note should be made on the process to the effect that the proper fee has been levied.

XIII.—A process issued by any Court in British territory should be served free of charge by any Court (including the Court of Small Causes at Bombay) in the Bombay Presidency, if it be certified in the process that the proper fee has been levied under the rules in force in the territory in which the Court issuing the process is situated.

XIV.—Processes issued by the Courts in Berar, Mysore, or by any of the Courts mentioned in the Government of India's Notification No. 368-I of 13th March 1881, republished at page 419 of the *Bombay Government Gazette* for 1885, Part I, to which the provisions

of Section 650A of the Code of Civil Procedure have been applied,\* shall be served free of charge by the Courts in the Bombay Presidency.

XV.—(a) Processes for service in the Straits

Processes to Straits Settlements should be forwarded to the Registrar of the Supreme Court at Singapore, Penang or Malacca, as the case may be, and should be ac-

companied by a sum sufficient to cover the fees for service and postage, the remittance being made by a Post Office Money Order.

(b) In summonses sent to the Resident at Hyderabad for service on persons residing in the territories of His Highness the Nizám, the name of each person's place of residence, that is the

The following Rules framed by the Honourable the Chief Justice and Judges of the High Court under Section 2 of Act III of 1879, the Destruction of Records Act, confirmed by the Government of Bombay and sanctioned by the Governor-General of India in Council, are published for general information:—

#### I.—DISTRICT AND SUBORDINATE COURTS.\*

(a) Where room is required, *but not otherwise*, the records of suits to which Section 586 of the Civil Procedure Code applies, with the exception of the plaint, judgment and decree, may be destroyed after the expiration of six years from the date of final decision.

Records of suits when to be destroyed.

The Register of suits in which these suits have been entered will be preserved and memorandum to be kept of suits destroyed. kept showing the numbers and years of the suits of which the records have been destroyed under these rules. The records of the older suits should be destroyed first.

(b) The records of all cases coming within the provisions of Section 10 of Regulation VIII of 1827 when to be destroyed, on the expiration of twelve years from the date of the final order made by the High Court under clause 4 of that section.

Records of cases under section 10 of Regulation VIII of 1827 when to be destroyed.

(c) The following records may be destroyed after the expiration of six years:—

#### II.—SMALL CAUSE COURTS.

(a) Where room is required, the papers and proceedings in all suits and miscellaneous proceedings, with the exception of the plaint or application, the decree or final order, and exhibits produced by the parties may be destroyed after the expiration of six years from the date of final decision or disposal.

Records of suits when to be destroyed.

(b) Rule 1 (c) above applies to Small Cause Courts.

## III.—MAMLATDARS' COURTS.

The records of suits in Mamlatdars' Courts, under Bombay Act III of 1876, may be destroyed after the expiration of six years from the date of final decision. The Registers in which such suits have been entered will be permanently preserved, and a book should be kept showing the numbers and years of the suits of which the records have been destroyed. The records of the older suits should be destroyed first.

Records of suits when to be destroyed. Registers to be permanently preserved.

## IV.—GENERAL RULES APPLICABLE TO ALL COURTS.

(a) In preparing the list of papers which is placed in each record before handing it to the Record-keeper a star (\*) shall be prefixed to the title and number of each document which, under any general or special rule, is to be permanently preserved. The papers themselves should in each case be similarly marked and should be placed at the top of the bundle so as to be easily separable from the rest.

(b) The date of destruction of unmarked papers is to be noted on the list, which shall be permanently preserved.

(c) Very great caution should be exercised that nothing may be destroyed but what the above rules authorize, and that no papers of the following descriptions are destroyed:—

Papers relating to public revenue accounts, or copies of accounts of revenue management of, or connected with, alienations of revenue by this or former Governments.

Title-deeds of, or relating to, immoveable property, or authenticated copies of the same.

(d) In all Courts which are allowed a vacation or vacations during the year, the selection of records for destruction shall be commenced at the beginning of each vacation and be continued *de die in diem* (excepting close holidays) until the work is completed. A sufficient number of the members of the establishment of each Court should be refused leave during the vacation until all records fit for destruction have been selected and destroyed.

(e) The destruction of useless records should be effected by tearing them into very small pieces, which should be sold to the highest bidder, or burnt, if no one bids at the sale.

RESOLUTION—By the Government of India, Department of Finance and Commerce.

The Governor-General in Council has decided that, without the special orders of the Govern-

ment of India, no officer of Government who is in receipt of furlough or leave allowance may take service under any other employer in India, and no officer whose services have been lent to any other employer in India can take leave or obtain leave allowances from the Government of India unless he actually quits his employment for the period of such leave.

**ORDER.**—Ordered, that this Resolution be communicated to the several Departments of the Government of India, Local Governments, Administrations, and Heads of Departments for information.

#### REVENUE DEPARTMENT.

*Bombay Castle, 12th July 1888.*

No. 4628.—Whereas it appears to the Governor of Bombay in Council that land is required to be taken by Government at the expense of the Municipality of Bombay for a public purpose, viz., for erecting a hut for the Registration Cemetery Clerk, in the village of Wadala in the city of Bombay; it is hereby declared that for the above purpose a piece of land measuring more or less 25 square yards, together with trees standing thereon, in Survey No. 4 in the village of Wadala, bounded on the north and east by the Fazindári ground of Antone Gasper Sill, and on the south and west by a passage leading from Mátunga road to the village of Wadala, is required within the aforesaid village of Wadala.

This declaration is made, under the provisions of Section 6, Act X of 1870, to all whom it may concern, who are hereby warned not to obstruct or interfere with persons employed on the land.

A plan of the above-mentioned plot can be seen at the office of the Collector of Land Revenue, Customs and Opium, Bombay.

## Notice to Mariners.

## BOMBAY HARBOUR.

*Buoys and marking Wrecks.*

Wreck-buoys in the approaches to the Harbour will be coloured green with the word "Wrecks" painted in white letters on them.

When possible, the buoy will be laid near to the side of wreck next to midchannel.

When a wreck-marking vessel is used, it will, if possible, have its top sides coloured green with the word "Wreck" in white letters thereon and shall exhibit—

*By day*—Three balls on a yard 20 feet above sea, two vertically at one end, and one at the other, the single ball being on the side nearest the wreck.

*By night*—Three white fixed lights similarly arranged, but not the ordinary riding light.

*In the Harbour.*

A wreck-marking boat or vessel will carry a cross yard on a mast at least 12 feet above water, with two balls 4 feet diameter, placed horizontally, not less than 6 or more than 12 feet apart by day; and by night two white lights similarly placed, lanterns to be globular, not less than 8 inches in diameter, of the same description as a ship's anchor light; the mark-boat will, if possible, be moored over the wreck.

Wreck-buoys may be used in places out of the usual track of vessels at the discretion of the Port Officer.

No. 46.—The following addition made by the Trustees of the Port of Bombay to the scale of rates, &c., leviable by them under Section 43 of the Bombay Port Trust Act, 1879, has been sanctioned by Government and is published for general information, viz.:—

"Charges for vessels entering the wet docks for repairs:

For vessels 250 feet long and under—Rs. 12 per diem.

For vessels over 250 feet in length—Rs. 18 per diem."

No. 47.—Under the provisions of Section 73 of the Bombay Port Trust Act, 1879, the following additional Dock Bye-law has been passed by the Trustees:—

"No. 33A.—Vessels requiring to carry out repairs in the Wet Docks may do so when a berth can be made available, on condition that when such berth is required for a working vessel it must be at once vacated for an off-side berth."

No. 48.—The following addition to Pilotage Bye-law No. 34, made by the Trustees of the

Port of Bombay under the provisions of Section 72 of the Bombay Port Trust Act, 1879, and published in Notification No. 42 dated 26th June 1888, on the 28th June and 5th and 12th July 1888, has received the approval of Government as required by Section 74 of the Bombay Port Trust Act, 1879:—

"Pilots are forbidden to bring sailing ships among the shipping at night, but there is no objection, if every precaution is taken, to sailing ships being taken to outside berths on clear moonlight nights, all prevailing circumstances being favourable."

No. 49.—The following alterations to Dock Bye-law No. 44, made by the Trustees of the Port of Bombay under Section 73 of the Bombay Port Trust Act, 1879, and published in Government Notification No. 43 dated 27th June 1888, on the 28th June and 5th and 12th July 1888, have received the approval of Government as required by Section 74 of the aforesaid Act:—

"For the words 'single packages' substitute 'goods weighing' and expunge the words 'in weight.'"

## GENERAL DEPARTMENT.

*Bombay Castle, 12th July 1888.*

No. 2422.—In exercise of the power conferred by Act I of 1870, the following Rules for Quarantine against Cholera have been made by the Government of Bombay, with the previous sanction of the Governor General in Council: they have effect from the 7th instant in the Port of Aden and at Perim as a temporary measure:—

I.—The Commander of every vessel, including buggalows or other native craft, arriving from the Persian Gulf shall, before entering the harbour, indicate by signal the port from which such vessel has come.

II.—Such Commander shall not, except as hereinafter provided, allow any communication, either with the pilot boat, except orally, or with the shore, or with any other vessel or boat in the harbour.

III.—Immediately on arrival the Commander shall cause the letter R of the Commercial Signal Code to be hoisted, and shall keep the said flag flying during his stay in port or until authorized by the Health Officer to haul it down. If communication with the shore is not desired, the vessel shall anchor at such place as may be pointed out by the Port authorities, having regard to the season of the year. If communication with the shore is desired, the Health Officer shall go alongside the vessel, and, after all necessary enquiries, shall direct the Commander to take the vessel to the quarantine anchorage duly appointed and notified in that behalf by the Resident, there to remain for a period of seven days from the date of arrival, or for the shorter period prescribed in Rule IV, and undergo disinfection, which should apply as well to crew, passengers, effects, and susceptible goods.

IV.—If the Health Officer of the Port has sufficient evidence that no cases of a suspicious nature have taken place on board during the voyage, and if the vessel is besides in good hygienic condition, the duration of the quarantine will be diminished according to the following scale:—

V.—If during the period a vessel is at the quarantine anchorage aforesaid, any case or cases of cholera should occur on board, the said vessel shall remain in quarantine for a period of seven days from the date of the last case occurring, and be subject to all the prohibitions provided for in Rule III.

VI.—When any vessel has been placed in quarantine as aforesaid, the Health Officer may direct the removal of so many of the passengers and crew as may not be suffering from illness, and whose services may not be required on board the vessel, to such particular spots as may from time to time be selected by the Resident as places of quarantine, there to remain for a period of seven days. If a case of cholera occurs among such passengers and crew during any such period, they shall remain in a place of quarantine for a period of fifteen days from the date of the occurrence of the last case of such illness.

VII.—Any mails or cargo which may be brought by any vessel so arriving shall be landed under such precautions as the Health Officer may deem necessary to prevent the spread of the disease.

VIII.—It will be the duty of the Port Officer to facilitate the conveyance to all vessels in quarantine of such supplies of provisions, stores and other articles as may be required by those on board. Such supplies will be placed on the boats of the vessels in quarantine to be subsequently removed by members of their crews.

IX.—All vessels arriving at Aden and Perim which may have communicated with vessels coming from the Persian Gulf shall be subjected to the same quarantine as vessels arriving at Aden and Perim from that Port.

X.—All vessels which have undergone quarantine in the manner above prescribed should have the fact clearly stated on their Bills of Health.

No. 340.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Cantonments Act, 1880, the Governor in Council is pleased, with the previous sanction of the Governor-General in Council, to impose from the August 1888 the following taxes in the Cantonment of Deesa, in supersession of the Property and Conservancy Rates imposed by Government Order No. 486 of 25th September 1882, published at pages 756–757 of the *Bombay Government Gazette* for 1882, Part I:—

## I.—Property Rates.

- (1) A consolidated rate of 4 per centum per annum of the annual value of houses, buildings and lands for the following purposes:—
  - (a) Two per centum for general purposes and for the protection from fire of those parts of the Cantonment which are not so protected by regimental or other special arrangements;
  - (b) One per centum towards defraying the cost of the maintenance of the Police force of the Cantonment;
  - (c) One per centum for the purpose of lighting:

Provided that the said consolidated rate shall not be leviable in respect of any hut or other building, the annual value of which does not exceed Rs. 12-8 and that the minimum annual amount of the said consolidated rate leviable in respect of any hut or other building the annual value of which exceeds Rs. 12-8 shall be one rupee.

- (2) A conservancy rate of the following monthly amounts, viz.:—

*In the Limits of the Bázár.*

- (a) For houses to which no privy is attached—

If the annual value exceeds 1 Rupee but does not exceed Rs. 3 ... ½ anna.

If the annual value exceeds Rs. 3 but does not exceed Rs. 25 ... 2 annas.

If the annual value exceeds Rs. 25 ... 4 annas.

- (b) For houses, buildings or holdings to which a privy is attached—

If the annual value does not exceed Rs. 20 ... 4 annas per privy.

If the annual value exceeds Rs. 20 but does not exceed Rs. 75 ... 8 annas per privy.

If the annual value exceeds Rs. 75 but does not exceed Rs. 100 ... 12 annas per privy.

If the annual value exceeds Rs. 100 but does not exceed Rs. 150 ... 1 Rupee per privy.

If the annual value exceeds Rs. 150 ... Rs. 1½ per privy.

- (c) For every cesspool appertaining to any house, building or holding which is unconnected with or detached from the privy, if any, attached to such house, building or holding—

If the annual value of such house, building or holding does not exceed Rs. 50 ... 6 annas.

If the annual value of such house, building or holding exceeds Rs. 50 ... Such amount as the Cantonment Magistrate, with the approval of the Cantonment Committee, shall from time to time fix in consideration of the duties to be performed in respect of each cesspool.

*Note.*—The conservancy rate under clause (c) for cesspools will be leviable in addition to the conservancy rate liable under clause (c) or clause (b).

*In the Limits of the Lines.*

(d) For each bungalow or other building with one or more privies attached, of which the annual value does not exceed Rs. 480 ... 1 Rupee.

(e) For each bungalow or other building with one or more privies attached, of which the annual value exceeds Rs. 480 ... 1½ Rupees.

(f) For each bungalow or other building with one or more privies attached, of which the annual value exceeds Rs. 720 ... 2 Rupees.

*In the Cantonment generally.*

- (g) For every hotel, club, messhouse, or other building or premises which the Cantonment Magistrate, with the approval of the Cantonment Committee, shall deem fit to exclude from the foregoing classification, such amount as the Cantonment Magistrate, with the approval of the Cantonment Committee, shall from time to time fix in consideration of the conservancy duties to be performed for such hotel, &c:

Provided that, in the limits of Bázars, the Cantonment conservancy establishment shall perform for houses, buildings and lands in respect of which the conservancy rate aforesaid is levied all the duties usually performed by halálkhors.
