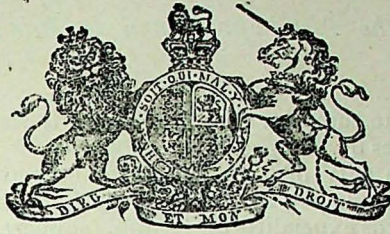

PROCEEDINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT, BOMBAY.

The following Report of the Select Committee of the Council of His Excellency the Governor of Bombay, on a Bill to enable Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the City of Bombay to assign part of the Municipal Fund to Educational and other public purposes, is, in accordance with Rule 25 of the Rules for the conduct of business at Meetings of the Council, published for general information :—

Report of the Select Committee appointed to consider “ a Bill to enable Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the City of Bombay to assign part of the Municipal Fund to Educational and other public purposes.”

The Committee appointed to report upon the “ Bill to enable Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the City of Bombay to assign part of the Municipal Fund to Educational and other public purposes,” beg to report that they approve of the principle of the Bill.

It has been suggested to the Committee that the purposes for which the Justices should be empowered to vote funds should be limited to those specified in Bombay Act No. II. of 1862, and the Committee has amended the Bill accordingly.

A copy of the Bill as amended by the Committee is appended to this Report.

Bill No. 1 of 1870.

A BILL to enable Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the City of Bombay to assign part of the Municipal Fund to Educational and other public purposes.

WHEREAS it is expedient to empower the Justices of the peace for the City of Bombay to assign part of the Municipal Fund towards expenditure upon Educational and other public purposes within the said city: It is enacted as follows:—

I. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Justices empowered to expend on Educational and other public purposes the Sanction of Go-

poses out of Municipal Fund. Justices in Special general meeting assembled, to expend part of the Municipal Fund upon the construction, support and maintainance of any Hospital, Dispensary, or School within the said city.

II. This Act shall be read as and taken to be part of (Bombay) Act II. of 1865.
Extended Application of this Act.
