PROCEEDINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT, BOMBAY.

The following Bill, together with the Statement of Objects and Reasons accompanying it, is published in accordance with Rule 15 of the Rules for the conduct of Business at Meetings of the Council of His Excellency the Governor of Bombay for the purpose of making Laws and Regulations.

Bill No. 4 of 1870.

A Bill for the repeal of (Bombay) Act No. II. of 1869.

WHEREAS it is expedient to reduce taxation for Municipal purposes within the City of Bombay; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Repeal of Bombay Act II. of 1869. of 1869 is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

On the passing of the Act now proposed for repeal His Excellency the Governor General of India gave the assent required by the Indian Councils' Act, 1861, on the distinct understanding that the Act would be repealed within the year. It has been reported to Government that the collection of the Tax for the year ending April 30th, 1870, has been completed, and the Bill is accordingly introduced.
