JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT.

Bombay Castle, 18th December 1909.

No. 7011.—The following rates for the hire of Motor-vehicles fitted with taximeters and used as public land-conveyances in the town and suburbs of Bombay have been fixed by the Commissioner of Police and sanctioned by the Governor in Council under section 14 of Bombay Act No. VI of 1863.

- 2. The said rates shall apply whether the conveyance is used by three or any lesser number of passengers.
 - I.—Day time (6-30 A.M. to 10-30 P.M.)—
 - (a) Within a radius of 5 miles from Victoria Railway Terminus which includes all places south of a line drawn through Worlee Sluice Bridge on the west and continued through New Parbhadevi Road by Elphinstone Road Station and Parel Station (Great Indian Peninsula) through Bhoiwada Road and Golanki Hill Road to Sewree Cemetery on the east.

(Tariff I) Annas 8 for the first 1,760 yards or 1 mile.

Annas 2 for each subsequent 440 yards.

 (Tariff II) (b) For journeys or hiring beyond the 5 miles radius— Annas 8 for the first 1,408 yards.

Annas 2 for each subsequent 352 yards.

- * (c) Return; journey-
 - If discharged by a customer outside the 5 miles radius— Annas 4 per 1,760 yards or less.
- II. (Tariff III) Night time (10-30 P.M. to 6-30 A.M.)-
 - (a) Annas 8 for the first 1,172 yards.Annas 2 for each subsequent 294 yards.
 - *(b) Return journey-

If discharged by a customer outside the 5 miles radius— Annas 6 per 1,760 yards.

- III.—Fare for detention of conveyance—
 Annas 2 for each 3 minutes.
- IV.—In addition to the above, the driver of any taxi-cab shall be entitled to charge—
 Annas 2 for each packet carried outside.

Note.—Luggage carried on the car so that the doors do not close over it is deemed to be outside within the meaning of this clause.
