“ CANTONMENTS.

REGULATIONS.

No. 707, dated Simla, the 23rd July 1909.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Cantonments Act, 1889 (XIII of 1889), and in modification of the notification of the Government of India in the Military Department,

No. 664,* dated the 16th June 1899, as subsequently amended, the Governor-General in Council is pleased to direct that the following amendments shall be made to the Cantonment Code, 1899, namely:—

To section 51 add the following:—

'Exception.—The provisions of this section do not apply to the Aden Cantonment fund, the accounts of which are audited by the Accountant General, Bombay.'

To section 52 add the following:—

'Exception.—The provisions of sub-sections (2) and (3), so far as they relate to the local audit of accounts, do not apply to the Aden Cantonment fund.'

- (a) to alter the limits of the port of Kāvi ;

For the limits of the port of Kāvi as defined in column 2 of the schedule to the said notification the following limits shall be substituted :—

- (b) to cancel so much of Government Notification in the Revenue Department, No. 2392-B., dated the 12th April 1901, as relates to the port of Dehegām.

IV.

(1) In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4, sub-section (1), clause (a), of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (XV of 1908), the Governor in Council is pleased, with the previous sanction of the Governor General in Council, to extend the said Act to the port mentioned in column 1 of the annexed schedule, the limits of the port being those defined in column 2 of the same schedule.

5. Instrument executed for the purpose of securing the repayment of a loan made, or to be made, under the Land Improvement Loans Act, 1883 (XIX of 1883), or the Agriculturists' Loans Act, 1884 (XII of 1884), including an instrument whereby a landlord binds himself to consent to the transfer, in the event of default in such repayment, of any land, or interest in land, on the security of which any such loan is made to his tenant.

No. 1770.—The Honourable the Chief Justice and Judges of His Majesty's High Court of Judicature at Bombay are pleased to make, under section 104 of the Transfer of Property Act, IV of 1882, the following rules for the guidance of the Civil Courts subordinate to the High Court, in substitution of those published in High Court Notification

No. 1195, dated the 22nd July 1904, at pages 1001-1002 of *Bombay Government Gazette*, Part I, for 1904, and incorporated after Circular No. 110 at page 62 of the High Court Civil Circular Order Book :—

I. In these Rules, unless there is something repugnant in the subject or context

“mortgagor” includes every person entitled under a decree or otherwise to redeem the mortgaged property ;

and

“mortgagee” includes every person entitled under a decree or otherwise to the rights of the mortgagee.

II. A mortgagor making a deposit or a payment into Court under Chapter IV of the Act shall file a verified petition stating the facts of the case.

III. Unless otherwise ordered, the mortgagor shall, in addition to the amount due, deposit or pay into Court a sum sufficient to provide for

(a) the mortgagee's costs of obtaining payment out of Court,

(b) the mortgagee's costs, when the payment is made under section 83 of the Act, of executing or registering (1) a re-conveyance in the case of an English mortgage, or (2) an acknowledgment of the discharge of the mortgage in other cases,

and

(c) the interest to which the mortgagee may be entitled under the 2nd para. of section 84 of the Act.

IV. The Court by endorsement on the mortgagor's petition may order the deposit or payment to be received by the Názir. Such order shall specify the several sums to be deposited or paid and the purpose for which each sum is intended.

V. The mortgagor's petition shall be entered in the Register of miscellaneous applications requiring judicial enquiry.

VI. Unless the mortgagee has already put in his appearance, the Court shall issue a notice of the deposit or payment to the mortgagee requiring him to deposit in Court on a day to be fixed by it all documents in his possession or power relating to the mortgaged property and also the mortgage-deed when such payment is made under section 83 of the Act.

VII. Subject to the provisions of section 102 of the Act, the notice shall be served and its service shall be proved in the manner prescribed by the Code of Civil Procedure and Civil Circular Orders.

VIII. Every application by a mortgagee to obtain payment of money out of Court shall be made by a verified petition accompanied by such of the documents mentioned in Rule VI as have not been deposited in Court and, when neces-

sary, by a draft deed of re-conveyance of the mortgaged property or acknowledgment of discharge of the mortgage as the case may be.

IX. A mortgagee applying for payment of money deposited under section 83 of the Act shall be required, if necessary, to deliver up possession of the mortgaged property to the mortgagor.

X. Every enforceable order under section 83 may be enforced under the provisions of the Code of Civil Procedure and shall for that purpose be deemed to have been made in a suit instituted under that Code.

XI. The provisions hereinbefore contained as to a mortgagor and mortgagee shall, so far as may be, respectively apply to the owner of immoveable property subject to a charge (as defined in section 100 of the Act) and the person having such charge.

Note.—Those rules which were formerly published and are now omitted are omitted because they could not now be made under section 104 of the Transfer of Property Act, IV of 1882, but would require to be made, if at all, under the new Code of Civil Procedure, Act V of 1908, which has repealed sections 85 to 90 inclusive, 92 to 94 inclusive, 96 to 97 and 99 and certain words in section 100 of the Transfer of Property Act and incorporated them as rules 1 to 8 inclusive, 10 and 12 to 15 inclusive of Order XXXIV of the Code.
