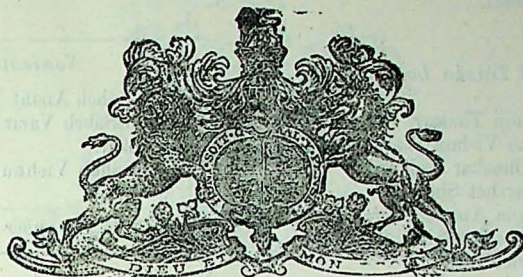

Bombay Castle, 4th January 1898.

No. 25.—In exercise of the power conferred by Section 27 of the Bombay Local Boards Act of 1884, His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to appoint Mr. Kharshedji Ratanji Bamanji to be President of the District Local Board of Ratnágiri with effect from the 1st instant.
