GENERAL DEPARTMENT.

Bombay Castle, 3rd February 1898.

No. 673.—Whereas the terms of office of the present members of the Táluka and District Local Boards in the Poona District terminate on the 31st March and 30th April 1898 respectively; and whereas it is convenient that the terms of office of the members of the said Boards should expire on the 30th April and 31st May 1898 respectively; the Governor in Council is pleased, in exercise of the power conferred by Section 14 of the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1884 (as amended by Section 1 of Bombay Act I of 1888), to direct that the terms of office of the present members of the Táluka and District Local Boards aforesaid be extended to the 30th April and 31st May 1898, respectively.
