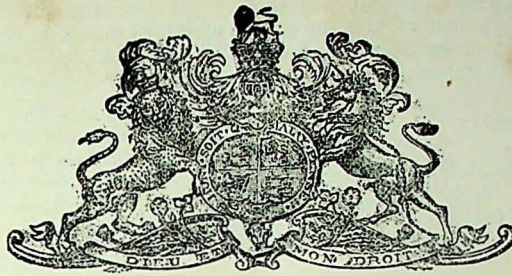

### Notifications under the Bombay Local Boards and District Municipal Acts.

No. 4669 A.—In exercise of the power conferred by Section 27 of the Bombay Local Boards Act of 1884, His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to appoint Ráo Bahádur Venkatrao Dattatraya Yennemadi to be President of the Táluka Local Boards of Kárwár, Ankola, Yellápúr and Haliyál in the Kánara District vice Mr. G. F. Keatinge, I. C. S., resigned.

No. 4708.—In exercise of the power conferred by Section 27 of the Bombay Local Boards Act of 1884, His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to appoint Ráo Bahádur Sakharam Chinnaji Joshi to be President of the Táluka Local Boards of Shirpur, Sindkheda and Chopda in the Khándesh District vice Mr. F. J. Varley, I. C. S., resigned.

No. 4717.—In supersession of so much of Government Notification No. 3640, dated the 23rd September 1885, published at pages 56—57 of the *Bombay Government Gazette* of 1885, Part I-A, as determines the total number of elective and nominated commissioners of the Municipality of Poona, His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased, under the provisions of Sections 11 and 12 (a) and (b) of the Bombay District Municipal Act Amendment Act, 1884, to direct—

(a) that the Poona City Municipality in the district of Poona shall on and after the 1st October 1898 consist of thirty-eight commissioners partly elected and partly nominated by the Commissioner, C. D.;

(b) that the number of elected commissioners shall be twenty and of those nominated by the Commissioner, C. D., shall be eighteen, of whom nine may be salaried servants of Government and nine shall be non-official private gentlemen.
