### NOTIFICATIONS.

SEA CUSTOMS.

No. 59.

Calcutta, the 13th March 1879.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 23 and 205 of the Sea Customs Act, 1878, the Governor General in Council is pleased to cancel so much of the Notification No. 43, dated the 18th March 1878, as relates to grey cotton piece-goods and to exempt from all Customs-duties all grey cotton piece-goods, howsoever designated, which are shewn to the satisfaction of the Customs-Collector, whose decision shall be final, to contain no yarn of a higher number than 30s.

This Notification shall take effect on and after the 15th March 1879.

No. 60.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 22 of the Sea Customs Act, 1878, the Governor General in Council is pleased, in modification of Schedule A of the Indian Tariff Act, 1875, to fix for the articles mentioned in the second column of the following Statement the Tariff values set forth in the fourth column of the same.

This Notification shall take effect on and after the 1st April 1879.
