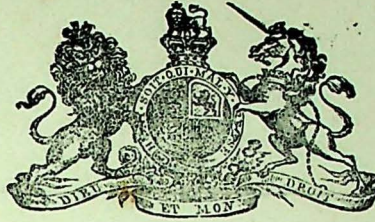

Bombay Castle, 14th March 1879.

No. 1400.—The following telegram, dated 14th instant, from the Government of India is published for general information:—

“After to-day so much of Notification No. 43 of 18th March 1878 as relates to Grey Cotton Piece Goods is cancelled, and all Grey Cotton Piece Goods howsoever designated which are shown to the satisfaction of Customs Collectors to contain no Yarn of a higher number than 30's are exempted from all Customs duties. Please notify all Collectors.”
