PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE GOVERNOR GENERAL OF INDIA.

Abstract of the Proceedings of the Council of the Governor General of India, assembled for the purpose of making Laws and Regulations under the Provisions of the Act of Parliament 24 § 25 Vic., Cap. 67.

The Council met at Simla, on Friday, the 2nd July 1869.

BHUTÁN DVÁRS BILL.

The Honourable Mr. COCKERELL presented the Report of the Select Committee on the Bill to exclude the ordinary Civil Courts from the cognizance of suits relating to land in the Bhután Dvárs, and to legalize certain Rules for the settlement of the said territory.

OPIUM TRANSSHIPMENT BILL.

The Honourable Mr. MAINE moved that the Honourable Messrs. STRACHEY, ELLIS, and COCKERELL be added to the Select Committee on the Bill for imposing a transshipment fee on opium.
