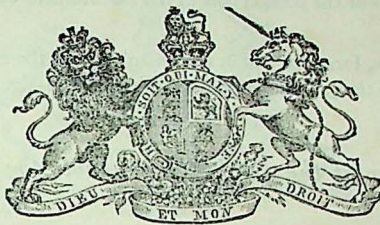

### PART I.

### Notification.

#### JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT.

*Bombay Castle, 19th July 1869.*

With reference to the Notification of Government in the Revenue Department, dated 10th July 1869, constituting the New Collectorates of Broach, Colaba, Sholapoor, and Nassick, the Right Honourable the Governor in Council is pleased to declare that the territory comprised in each of these Collectorates shall form the local jurisdiction of a Magistrate of a District.

The territory forming the Collectorates of Broach, Colaba, and Sholapoor shall continue as heretofore to be included in the Judicial Districts, Civil and Criminal, of Surat, Tanna, and Poona respectively, and all persons, who, as holding Office or resident within the former Sub-Collectorates of Broach, Colaba, and Sholapoor, have been vested with all or any of the powers of a Magistrate or Subordinate Magistrate, or with special powers conferred under any law, shall continue to exercise the same powers in the Magisterial Districts of Broach, Colaba, and Sholapoor respectively.

The Collectorate of Nassick shall be included within the limits of the Judicial District, Civil and Criminal, of Tanna.

All persons who, as holding office or resident within the portions of the Khandeish and Ahmednuggur Collectorates which have been transferred to the Nassick Collectorate, have been vested with all or any of the powers of a Magistrate or Subordinate Magistrate, or with special powers conferred under any law, shall continue to exercise the same powers in the Nassick Magisterial District.

The Subordinate Judges of the Districts of Khandeish and Ahmednuggur, the Stations of whose Courts have been transferred to the District of Nassick, are appointed to be Subordinate Judges of similar grade and class in the Tanna District.

The Talooka of Akola, formerly within the jurisdiction of the Subordinate Judge at Sungumnair, shall be included within the local limits of the jurisdiction of the Subordinate Judge at Sinnur, in the District of Tanna.

The Talooka of Kopergaum, formerly within the jurisdiction of the Subordinate Judge at Yeola, shall be included within the local limits of the jurisdiction of the Subordinate Judge at Rahooree, in the Ahmednuggur District.
