No. 857.—His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief of Her Majesty's Naval Forces in India having made arrangements to take leave of His Excellency Lord Habris on board the P. & O. S. N. Company's S.S. Clyde, and to greet the Right Honourable Lord Sandhurst on board the S.S. Ganges, instead of on shore, the following words in paragraph 5 of Government Notifications, Political Department, Nos. 651 and 652, dated the 28th ultimo, published in a Bombay Government Gazette Extraordinary dated the 4th instant, should be eliminated:—

- 2nd line.—His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief of Her Majesty's Naval Forces in India, if in Bombay.
- 8th line.—The Senior Naval Officer of the Station in the absence of His Excellency the Naval Commander-in-Chief.
- 10th line.—The Naval Officers Commanding any of Her Majesty's Ships in harbour, if able to attend on shore.
