#### POLITICAL DEPARTMENT.

*Bombay Castle, 6th February 1895.*

No. 857.—His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief of Her Majesty's Naval Forces in India having made arrangements to take leave of His Excellency LORD HARRIS on board the P. & O. S. N. Company's S.S. *Clyde*, and to greet the Right Honourable LORD SANDHURST on board the S.S. *Ganges*, instead of on shore, the following words in paragraph 5 of Government Notifications, Political Department, Nos. 651 and 652, dated the 28th ultimo, published in a *Bombay Government Gazette Extraordinary* dated the 4th instant, should be eliminated:—

*2nd line.*—His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief of Her Majesty's Naval Forces in India, if in Bombay.

*8th line.*—The Senior Naval Officer of the Station in the absence of His Excellency the Naval Commander-in-Chief.

*10th line.*—The Naval Officers Commanding any of Her Majesty's Ships in harbour, if able to attend on shore.
