Notifications under the Bombay Local Boards and District Municipal Acts.

GENERAL DEPARTMENT.

Bombay Castle, 27th May 1895.

No. 2126.—With reference to the Notification No. 576, dated 12th February 1895, issued by the Governor in Council under the provisions of Section 10 of the Bombay District Municipal Act Amendment Act II of 1884, and published at page 13, Part I-A, of the *Bombay Government Gazette* dated 14th idem, announcing a proposal to alter the limits of the Bulsár Municipality, the Governor in Council is pleased, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 5 and 10 of the aforesaid Act, to direct that as no objections have been made to the said proposal, the following shall henceforth be the limit of the said municipal district :—

East—Bombay Baroda and Central India main line.

North—The Auranga river.

West—Road to Tithal beyond Survey No. 22 of the suburb of Mográwádi, the western boundary of Survey Nos. 34, 33, 30, 24, 23, eastern boundary of the Rakhadu tank, the western boundary of Roshanali Pir tomb, western boundary of Survey No. 498 and Mochiwád, and thence the western boundary of Survey Nos. 490, 489, 488, 469, 471, 218, 220, 221 and 222.

South—The southern boundary of Survey Nos. 562, 74, 75, 83, 45, 46 and 43.
