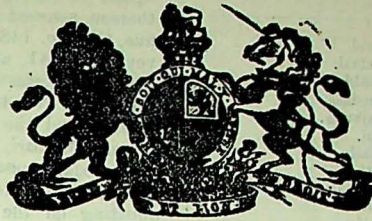

No. 8484.—Whereas it appears to the Governor of Bombay in Council that land is required to be taken by Government at the public expense for a public purpose, namely, for the extension of Wári Bandar Road at Mázgaon Naughar in the City of Bombay; it is hereby declared that for the above purpose a piece of land measuring more or less 82

square yards, together with the building standing thereon, assessed by the Collector of Land Revenue, Old No. 148, New No. 11789, and New Survey No. 3541, and assessed by the Collector of Municipal Rates and Taxes under Ward No. 5362 and Street No. 48,—bounded on the north by a passage and the house of Mahomed Haji Meya Mamry Malbari, on the south by a passage and Mahomedan mosque and the house of Khojia Mahomedbhoy Molubhoy, on the east by a passage abutting on the property of Jamalbibí, wife of Sahebkhán Hassankhán, and on the west by a passage and the house of Sakinabí, wife of Syeud Hussáin Khán Syeud Ahamed and the Mahomedan mosque,—is required within the aforesaid village of Mázgaon Naughar.

This declaration is made under the provisions of Section 6, Act I of 1894, to all whom it may concern, who are hereby warned not to obstruct or interfere with persons employed on the land.

A plan of the abovementioned property can be seen at the office of the Collector of Land Revenue, Customs and Opium, Bombay.
