#### LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.

The following Act of the Governor General of India in Council received the assent of His Excellency the Governor General on the 10th September 1896, and is hereby promulgated for general information :-

## Act No. XV of 1896.

An Act to amend the Glanders and Farcy Act. 1879.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend XX of 1879. the Glanders and Farcy Act, 1879; It is hereby enacted as follows:

> 1. In section 1 of the said Act, as amended Amendment of section 1, by Act XXIV of 1886, ct XX, 1879. by Act XXIV of 1886, territories respectively administered by the Governor of Fort St. George in Council and the Lieutenant-Governor of Bengal" are repealed.

- 2. To section 7 of the said Act the words " Provided that when the Amendment of sections 7 and 8, Act XX, 1879. Inspector is also a Veterinary Practitioner so appointed he may make the examination himself" shall be added, and in sections 7 and 8, for the word "Surgeon," wherever it occurs, the word "Practitioner" shall be sub-
- 3. To the said Act, as amended by the Repeal-Addition of a section to ing and Amending Act, XII of 1 Act XX, 1879. 1891, the following section shall be added, namely:

An Act to amend the Indian Post-office Act, 1866.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Indian XIV of 1866. Post-office Act, 1866; It is hereby enacted as follows:

Recovery of duty of customs paid by postal authorities.
