The following Bill, together with the Statement of Objects and Reasons accompanying it, is published in accordance with Rule 15 of the Rules for the conduct of Business at Meetings of the Council of His Excellency the Governor of Bombay for making Laws and Regulations

Bill No. 2 of 1894.

A Bill to amend the Aden Port Trust Act, 1888.

Bo. A. v. of WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Aden Port Trust Act, 1888, in manner hereinafter appearing; It is enacted as follows:--

> "14. Every trustee shall be entitled Fee payable to trustees. to a fee of such amount not exceeding thirty rupees as shall from time to time be prescribed by Government, for each meeting of the Board at which a quorum is present and business is transacted, and which he attends from the beginning to the end thereof : provided that if more than one such meeting is held in any one week,

no more than one fee shall be paid to any trustee for his attendance at all or any of such meetings during that one week."

2. To section 25 of the said Act, the Amendment of section 25. viz.:-

"(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in or done under this section, the crane on the Post Office pier entered as No. 23 in the said schedule shall, whenever and so long as the use thereof may be required by or on behalf of Government, be rendered by the Board available for such use, free of charge."

"(4) The property specified in Schedule C. shall, on and after such date as shall be notified in this behalf by the Governor in Council, vest in the Board."

" (c) such sums as Government may from time to time require the Board to contribute on account of expenses in connection with the harbour-police and police employed in guarding the docks, warehouses, and other property of the Board and on account of medical services supplied in the port, in lieu of, or in addition to, any expenditure which Government may direct to be made from the funds or hospital portdues, the control or application of which is, by sections 36 and 50 of the Indian Ports Act, 1889, vested in Government." (2) After Schedule B. annexed to the said Act there shall be added Schedule C. contained in Schedule No. II. annexed to this Act.
