The following Report of the Select Committee of the Council of His Excellency the Governor of Bombay, on the Bill to consolidate and amend the law relating to the Powers and Procedure of Mámlatdárs' Courts, is, in accordance with Rule 25 of the Rules for the Conduct of Business at Meetings of the Council, published for general information:—

The Select Committee appointed to consider Bill No. 2 of 1876 (a Bill to consolidate and amend the law relating to the Powers and Procedure of Mámlatdárs' Courts) have the honour to report that, having communicated with the Government of India and ascertained from them that there is no objection to the enactment in the Local Council of a measure providing a special period of limitation for a particular class of suits such as Section 21 of the Bill purports to provide, they are of opinion that the Bill requires no amendment and should be passed in its present form.
