

RESOLUTION—By the Government of India, Department of Finance and Commerce.

A question having been raised as to whether Stock Notes are to be received as collateral security from contractors in the same way as ordinary Government Promissory Notes are received, the Governor General in Council is pleased to decide that there shall be no distinction between the two classes of Notes so far as security deposits are concerned. As, however, the interest on Stock Notes is payable to bearer and the notes are transferable without endorsement, His Excellency in Council considers that they should always, if possible, be lodged in Government Treasuries for safe custody when tendered as security to any officer of Government. The necessary instructions for their safe custody in Treasuries will be issued in due course by the Comptroller General.

ORDERED, that this Resolution be communicated for information and guidance as follows:—

To the several Departments of the Government of India.

To the several Local Governments and Administrations.

To the Comptroller General and several Accountants General.

To the several Heads of Departments administered by the Government of India in this Department.

No. 3346A.—The following telegram from Her Britannic Majesty's Ambassador at Constantinople, dated 26th instant, is published for general information:—

"Your telegram of the eighth. Dutch Government inform their Minister that they have no information as to an improved sanitary condition of Batavia; consequently Board of Health decline for the present to make any change in orders as to quarantine. Board of Health still maintain that all pilgrim-laden ships must perform quarantine at Island of Camaran, in default of which they will be turned back from Jeddah or other Turkish ports in the Red Sea, and that other ships coming from any port of India where cholera exists must be subject to rules laid down in Articles four and five of the Regulations of 1867. English Delegate states that if Resident at Aden will apply these latter rules to home pilgrim ships, and refuses pratique to ships laden with pilgrims, Aden will be in free pratique with all Ottoman ports. Sent to Aden. If desirable please repeat to other authorities in India."

No. 151 Ex.—An International Exhibition of Colonial productions and articles of general exportation and works of art will be held at Amsterdam in May 1883, to which the Government of India has decided to send samples of raw products, and articles of manufacture other than art or ornamental ware. Exhibits will be ranged under the following classes:—

I.—Animal Products.

1. Wool and hair.
2. Silk, raw, and cocoons.
3. Hides, skins, leather and horns.
4. Butter, oils, fat and grease.
5. Fish.
6. Wax and honey.
7. Musk.
8. Others.

II.—Mineral Products.

Exhibits of the above classes will be received from private exhibitors under the following conditions:—

- (1) Each sample should not ordinarily exceed 2 lbs. in weight. [This restriction will not apply to such articles as carpets, mats, rope, cordage, &c., which will be taken in a reasonable quantity.]
- (2) Freight and all other cost to be paid by the exhibitor up to its arrival at Calcutta. All subsequent charges will be paid by Government.
- (3) Samples should ordinarily be put up in small cloth bags of a uniform size, the standard size being that capable of containing one lb. of wheat or rice. Any exhibitor will, however, be allowed to display samples in an ornamental show case, if provided and transmitted to the Exhibition at his own expense.
- (4) A label should be attached to each sample on which should be legibly written—
 - (a) Name of district where produced.
 - (b) Name and address of exhibitor.
 - (c) Name of article.
 - (d) Name of variety (if different varieties are sent).
 - (e) Wholesale price of the article at the place of production.
- (5) Samples of ordinary articles exceeding 2 lbs. in weight, but not exceeding 40 lbs. (half a maund), will be admitted for exhibition if the exhibitor will pay the freight and provide, or pay for the construction of, suitable cases.
- (6) Permission to send exhibits through the Government agency should be obtained before their despatch. Application for permission will not be received after the 1st of December, and the latest date up to which exhibits will be received is 1st of January 1883.

The Government of India has appointed Babu T. N. Mukharji to superintend operations connected with the collection of exhibits for Amsterdam. Communications which do not require reference to the Government of India should be addressed to Babu T. N. Mukharji, Officer in charge of Amsterdam Exhibits, Revenue and Agricultural Department, Calcutta.

No. 190.—The Governor General in Council is pleased to order that the following additions and modifications be made to Rules Nos. 37, 41, and 42 of the Rules and Rates for Inland Telegrams:—

Add as footnote to Rule 37—

'The sender of a State message addressed to a Government official may not prepay a reply; and in the case of a State message addressed to other than a Government official, any sum deposited by the sender under this rule must be intended for no other purpose than to cover the cost of a return telegram.'

For the present Rules 41 and 42 substitute the following:—

'Rule 41.—No refund will, under any circumstances, be made for a State message of any class, or for a 'local' or 'deferred' private message; and no refund will be made for an 'ordinary' or 'urgent' private message and delivered wholly or partially in an unintelligible state, unless the extra charge for repetition has been paid by the sender.'

'Rule 42.—If an 'ordinary' or 'urgent' private message be not delivered, or be subjected to serious delay through the fault of the Telegraph Department, the whole charge made for it will be returned to the sender.'

2. If there have been no sales during the month, but only renewals, the credit and the deduct entry will of course be equal, and the cash balance will be unaffected.

3. The purchaser of a Stock Note has to pay the par value plus the accrued interest and he has the option of claiming immediate payment of the coupon next due. It is hardly likely that the purchaser will not claim payment of the coupon; but if this case should occur, it should be referred for orders.
