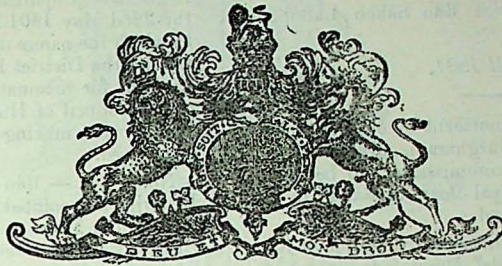

Bombay Castle, 20th April 1901.

No. 2290.—In exercise of the power conferred by Section 69 of the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1884, the Governor in Council is pleased to make the following addition to No. 5 of the rules made under that Act for the election of members of

Local Boards published in Government Notification specified in the margin, and to direct that it should be inserted between the second and third paragraphs of the existing rule :

“Should only one such nomination be made, the person nominated shall be deemed to be elected, and in such case the Mámlatdár or Mahálkari shall, on the completion of the period within which nominations may be made, declare the result of the election and communicate it to the Collector as under Rule 16 following.”
