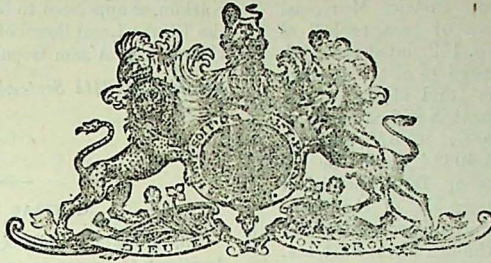

North—Revision Survey Numbers 1571, 1572, 1573, 1574, 1584, 1600, 1599, 1705, 1386, 1687, 1688, 1651, 1649, 1900, 1898, 1897, 1903, 1904, 1905, 1914, 1915, 870, 871, 867, 866, 865, and roads to Samadra, Parsantaj and Mehmabad and the portion of the nála (known as the Nilkant Mahadev's Nála) touching the Survey Numbers 1649 and 1900: excepting the Mehmabad Road in charge of the Public Works Department.

East—Revision Survey Numbers 864, 768, 766, 765, 759, 758, 741, 132, 181, 2122, half of the Survey Numbers 165 and 163, Survey Numbers 161, 161, 160, 159, 115, 116 and roads to Katakpura, the Camp and the portion of the nála touching the Survey Numbers 741 and 182, excepting the Camp road in charge of the Public Works Department.

South—The bed of the river Shedhi.

West—The bed of the river Watrak.
