GENERAL DEPARTMENT.

Bombay Castle, 21st October 1901.

No. 5999A.—Under Section 144 of the Bombay District Municipal Act, 1901, the Governor in Council is pleased to confer on the Ahmednagar Municipality all the powers specified in clauses (b), (c), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j) & (k) of sub-section (2) of the said section.

No. 5999B.—Under sub-section (2) of Section 145 of the Bombay District Municipal Act, 1901, the Governor in Council, being satisfied that the Ahmednagar Municipal District is threatened with an outbreak of a dangerous disease, viz. plague, is pleased to confer on that Municipality all the powers specified in clause (b) of sub-section (3) of the said section.

No. 6036B.—In exercise of the power conferred by clauses (a) and (b) of Section 11 of the Bombay District Municipal Act, 1901, and in supersession of Government Notifications specified in the margin, the Governor in Council is pleased to direct that each of the Municipalities of Bulsar, Dholka, Virangam and Godhra shall consist of sixteen councillors, inclusive of the President, of whom eight shall be elected and the rest nominated, and that of the nominated councillors four may be salaried servants of Government.
