Whereas CAWASJEE RUSTOMJEE TOORKEY, inhabitant of Aden, and trading under the name of Nusserwanjee Ruttonjee & Co., died at Aden on or about the 6th day of July 1869, and whereas Buchoobace, the widow of the said deceased, and Pestonjee Rustomjee Toorkey, lawfully constituted attorney for Veerbaeejee, the mother of the said deceased, have presented an application to the Acting Political Resident of the said Court, for the purpose of being formally recognized as heiresses and Executrices of the said Cawasjee Rustomjee Toorkey; This is to give notice to all persons who may dispute the right of the said Buchoobace and Veerbaeejee as heiresses and Executrices of the said Cawasjee Rustomjee Toorkey, to appear in the Court of the said Acting Political Resident, within one month from the date of this proclamation, there to enter their objection; and it is hereby declared, that if no sufficient objection is offered, before the expiration of that period, the said Acting Political Resident will forthwith receive proof of the said Buchoobace's and Veerbaeejee's rights, and will grant them, provided they shall appear entitled thereto, a certificate of heiressship and Executrixship of the said Cawasjee Rustomjee Toorkey deceased.—Dated at Aden this 24th day of September 1869.
