- 2. No revenue of any description has been surrendered by Government to the Municipality.
- 3. Realisations from the source of revenue authorised by Government have been credited during the year to which the account relates.
- 4. The amount of annual expenditure sanctioned by Government Resolution No. 1092 of the 2nd June 1866 for Establishment and Contingencies, is Rs. 468. The cost and strength is within Government sanction.
